In a Game Jam, participants come together to make games (video games, board games or other kinds of games). Each participant works in a small team on a complete game project over the course of a limited time period, usually a weekend.

The Global Game Jam (GGJ) is **the largest game jam in the world** and takes place in the same weekend in dozens of countries.

All participants in the Global Game Jam will be constrained by the same rules and limitations including a global theme to be revealed at the start of the jam.
